### **Computer Science Assistant Professor**

The Computer Science Department invites applications for a tenure-track assistant professor position starting Fall 2004. A PhD in Computer Science or Information Systems with a strong background in Computer Science is required. A strong commitment to undergraduate teaching and excellent communication skills are also required. The successful candidate will be expected to establish a research program. The college and the department highly value research in which undergraduates can participate.

The department has 11 tenure-track faculty and more than 100 majors. The department maintains a successful internship program for its majors and primarily offers courses to Computer Science, Mathematics, and Business majors. The department offers a major and minor in Computer Science, an Information Systems minor, and certificates in Computer Science and in Information Systems.

Our facilities include several Unix-based servers and five computer labs with a variety of software and development tools. These systems are supported by a full-time departmental systems administrator.

Siena College is a liberal arts college with a Franciscan and Catholic tradition of 3000 full-time undergraduates. The average class size is less than 20 students; the maximum class size is 35. Siena is located just north of Albany in upstate New York. There are many cultural, professional, and recreational opportunities in the area.
